4-40-030: Provisional Appointment:

(1) Provisional appointment shall be made only in the absence of an appropriate eligibility list for the position to be filled. In such case, the appointing authority may select a person meeting the minimum qualifications for the position for nomination to the Secretary/Chief Examiner. The hiring authority may interview or use any other method to determine whether the nominee possesses the necessary qualifications for the position. If satisfactory, the nominee will be certified for provisional appointment.

(2) No provisional appointment shall continue longer than six (6) months, and no person provisionally appointed may be again so appointed in the same twelve-month period. No time spent as a provisional appointee shall be credited toward any probationary period, nor shall it be utilized for computing any privilege accruing under Civil Service law or these rules.
