

US 395/Ridgeline Drive Interchange



The City of Kennewick is in the final design phase of a new interchange on US 395 at Ridgeline Drive. The interchange will improve access, reduce congestion, and reduce the probability of intersection-related collisions by creating a grade separation with Ridgeline Drive traffic crossing under US 395.

The project includes construction of on and off ramps at Ridgeline Drive, as well as widening the west side of US 395 between I-82 and Ridgeline Drive and the east side of US 395 between Ridgeline Drive and Hildebrand Boulevard. A new roundabout will be constructed at the northbound off ramp where it intersects with Ridgeline Drive and Zintel Way. Bofer Canyon Road will be realigned to the east to allow for construction of this off ramp. Additional left turn lanes will also be added to all legs at the US 395/Hildebrand Boulevard intersection. Construction is planned for 2020 through 2021.
