



# SHARRON AND RAINIER WATER IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

## To: Property Owners

Due to the ever-rising number of call-outs for repairs on an aging waterline in your neighborhood, the City has decided to upgrade your system to current standards. To accomplish this, the existing water main will be relocated from your backyard easement out into the public street. In addition, the system will be designed to allow for water meter services to be located at your street frontage rather than the back side of your residence.

In the next several weeks, engineering staff will complete a topographic survey of the roadway and waterline easement to help in the design process. Engineering staff will be submitting a request to local utilities to locate their utility lines, anticipate seeing utility workers and utility paint markings on site.



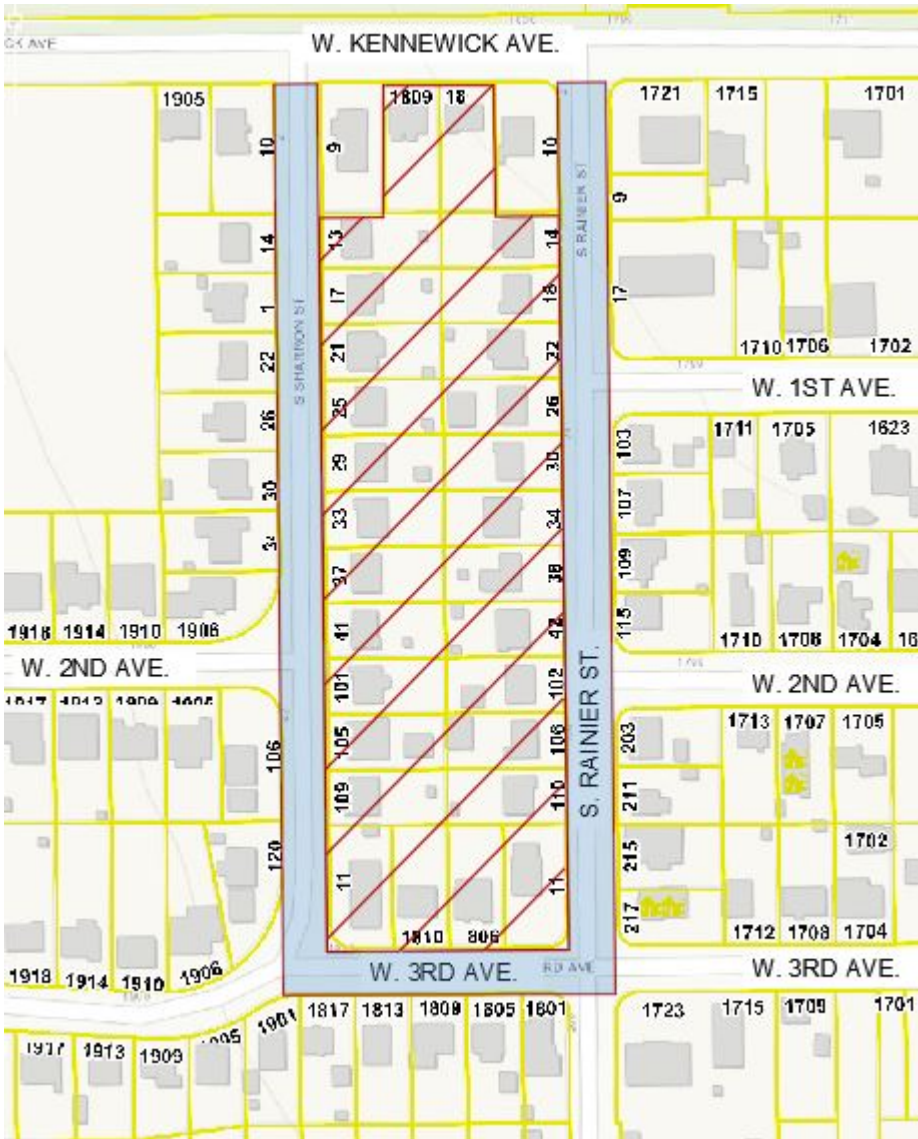
As part of the project design, staff will determine how the water improvements will impact your property. Engineering staff may need to schedule and meet with each property owner impacted by the work to receive comments and to review such items as driveway reconstruction, landscape restoration, other property impacts, and restoration requirements.

The current estimated project schedule is for design to take place this fall, solicitation for bids in January 2021, and construction in late spring of 2021.
