Summary of Incident / Details:

On October 30th, 2021 at 8:09AM Officers were dispatched to a Robbery just occurring in the 2500 block of W 4th Ave. The Victim called 911 after being robbed at gunpoint. He reported that a white Mazda CX5 bearing Nevada License Plate 145R03 arrived in a parking lot near him and 3 masked males exited. One of the males was holding a firearm and approached him demanding personal property. When the victim attempted to flee, he was struck in the face several times prior to the suspects taking property and driving away in the vehicle. The vehicle was listed as a stolen through the Kent Police Department. The vehicle was last seen fleeing north bound on US 395. The victim received treatment from the Kennewick Fire Department for minor injuries. At this time, the incident appears to be isolated and there is not a general threat to the public.
