

TEMPORARY HEAT PUMP EXEMPTION APPLICATION

This application and manufacturer warranty commitment must be provided prior to the issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy. Exemptions are only available for 120 days from October 21, 2021.

BUILDER REQUIREMENTS

- Builder provides a contract for install of the proposed unit and a backup heat source capable of meeting IRC R303.10 or IBC 1203.1 is provided.
- Builder acknowledges there will likely be a higher utility cost to the homeowner for exclusively running emergency heat.
- Builder acknowledges there will be an additional cost for a mechanical permit to install the correct WSEC approved heat pump when it becomes available.

HVAC CONTRACTOR REQUIREMENTS

- HVAC Contractor acknowledges there will likely be a higher utility cost to the homeowner for exclusively running emergency heat.
- HVAC Contractor acknowledges there will be an additional cost for a mechanical permit to install the correct WSEC approved heat pump when it becomes available.
