Summary of Incident / Details:

On 1/23/2022 at about 0148 hours, Kennewick Police were dispatched to the 300 block of S. Osborne St. in Kennewick (Benton County) WA. for a report of a weapons complaint. The reporting party advised that someone had shot at her house.

Police arrived on scene and located numerous small caliber shell casings in the area as well as bullet strikes at the residence itself. No one was injured at the residence. Police canvassed the area, to include the neighboring residences and no other victims and/or damage was located.
