Summary of Incident / Details:

On 2/6/22 at approximately 2135 hours, Kennewick Police were dispatched to a report of a woman lying in the roadway in the 5000 block of W. Clearwater Ave. Police arrived on scene and discovered a 28-year-old female had been struck by a car while crossing the street. Kennewick Fire department and Medics arrived on scene as well, attempting to stabilize the female before ultimately transporting her to the hospital, where she is in critical condition.

The driver and occupants of the suspect vehicle, upon striking the female, pulled to the side of the road and fled on foot. Kennewick Police K-9 arrived and performed a track of the area, locating property belonging to the suspect(s). The track was unable to locate the occupants of the vehicle.

The Kennewick Police Department Traffic Unit is actively investigating the incident.
