RIDE-ALONG RULES OF CONDUCT

Attachment 300.7.C

RIDERS SHALL BE REQUIRED TO COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING RULES:

Individuals participating in the Kennewick Fire Department Ride-Along Program shall adhere to the following requirements:

1. Behave in a manner consistent with the mission, vision and values of the Kennewick Fire Department.
2. Follow all directions received from the Officer to which they are assigned and not interfere or distract the officer or firefighters in the performance of their official duties.
3. At the start of the ride-along, inform the officer of any reasonable accommodations needed due to a disability or medical condition.
4. Dress in appropriate attire and appropriate footwear.
5. Refrain from taking photos or videos during the ride-along, posting information about emergency incidents they respond to on social media or sharing any HIPPA protected information about emergency incidents they respond to.
6. Refrain from carrying any firearm or concealed weapon during their ride-along.
7. Not be under the influence of or affected by any intoxicants, drugs, or medication.
8. Be symptom free of any illnesses. Riders experiencing any symptoms of illness (fever, cough, etc.) are not permitted to participate in a ride-along due to the potential of spreading the illness.
9. Immediately report any injuries sustained to the Officer to which they are assigned.
10. Wear a seat belt at all times while the vehicle they are riding in is in motion.
11. Wear the "Observer" vest while on all emergency incident scenes.

12. Refrain from using any physical fitness training equipment.

13. Come prepared with food, snacks, and beverages and understand that meal times are not guaranteed.
